Yr 13 Intervention Timetable

To support year 13 and ensure that they achieve the best possible grades we have put together an intervention programme. I am writing to encourage you to support us in ensuring that students access this intervention which is put on by the school. Lots of the intervention we provide happens within the classroom, however in some cases we do ask students to attend extra sessions. This helps us to develop specific examination skills.

I have attached the intervention timetable which is available for students to access. If your child has been asked to attend intervention it is vital that they do so, however the sessions will be open to all students who take the subject in year 13.

You will be aware that year 13 have their first set of mock examinations after the October half term. We ask that students consider reducing their hours at paid jobs and consider carefully the commitments they have outside of school as examinations draw nearer. We want to encourage students to stay healthy and positive as exams approach and support their wellbeing, however the amount of work students will need to do to prepare will naturally increase.

We are working with students to support their independent learning habits through our Enrichment lessons and are using a programme called Revision Evolution to ensure students are using the most effective revision methods. Please do ask students about their revision plans and hold them to account at home by checking in on them.

The next few months are critical in your child's academic life, and we want to do all we can to support them to get the best possible grades. To achieve at A level takes a huge amount of work and your support in encouraging them at home and making sure they are using their time wisely and attending interventions is critical.
